**COMMITTEE REPORTS**

- **Treasurer's Report for period ending February 28, 2025 – Sandy Smith**
  - Total income is budgeted to be \$2,400 which includes membership dues of \$2,200.
  - Total expenses are forecast to be \$2,429, leaving us with a slight loss for the year of \$29.
  - The main expenses are \$1,000 for Tournament Chair, \$500 for DBGCC staff Christmas tips, \$400 for Sunshine and \$200 for Christmas gifts to our Captain and Tournament Chair.
  
- **Tournament Report – Cathy Houston**
  - The 27<sup>th</sup> of March is make your own foursome.
  - There are only 2 play days in April, the 10<sup>th</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup>.
  - The combined tournament for the Club Championship and the Net Championship will be May 6<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup>.
  
- **Team Play Reports – Annette Krey and Frances Shipilov**
  - The new Team Play shirts are in.
  - There are two overlap dates for team play, May 29<sup>th</sup> and July 31<sup>st</sup>.
  - CV A players are capped at a handicap index of 22 or less.
  
- **Junior Golf – Doris Bunnell**

- We donated \$320 to Liberty Girls Golf.
  - There is a junior member of DBGCC on the team this year.
  - Discussion on if we want to start donating to Youth on Course.
  - We also discussed if we should change when we donate money to the beginning of the season so the money can be used at the start instead of when the season is over.
